## **2007 Heroes' Meet on Electronic Pollution Control – A Debate on the Management Catalog for the Pollution Control Priorities of Electronic Information Products (or Priority Management Catalog for the Pollution Control of Electronic Information Products)**

Dear Hero:

Since the promulgation of “Administrative/Management Measures for the Control of Pollution by Electronic Information Products” on February 28, 2006, the principle of catalog management and gradual phase-in has been adopted and will be implemented in two steps/phases: 1. After declarations of all products on March 1, 2007, the post-market management will be implemented; 2. After entering the phase of self-declaration + 3C certification based on “Management Catalog for the Pollution Control Priorities of Electronic Information Products”, the market access management will be implemented.

During the recent China-Germany RoHS Forum, the Deputy Director of MII’s Economic Structure Reform and Economy Operation Department, Wang, Bing-Ke (王秉科) reported that the pollution control measures will be implemented smoothly, and that the first step has been successfully introduced, and the second step is in preparation for introduction.

In concert with the development of the Management Catalog for the Pollution Control Priorities of Electronic Information Products, the China Quality Management Association for Electronics Industry is organizing this “2007 Heroes’ Meet on Electronic Pollution Control – A Debate on the Management Catalog for the Pollution Control Priorities of Electronic Information Products” (“Meet”). The purpose of this Meet is to gather the comments and recommendations from businesses and interested parties, to the development and supervision of the Catalog and mandatory certification, in accordance with open, transparent and fair principles, in order to smoothly promote the control of pollution caused by electronics, and in preparation for the promulgation of the Catalog.

During this Meet, the best debaters will be appointed by the participating representatives and the guests. The arrangement for the Meet is as follows:

I. Date: December 19, 2007

II. Place: Beijing

III. Organizer: China Quality Management Association for Electronics Industry

IV. Supporting Organizations:

V. Meeting Program

1. Current Development Status of the Catalog and the Interpretation to the Development Program of the Catalog – Director Huang (黄建忠), Economic Structure Reform and Economy Operation, MII
2. Relationship between the Catalog and 3C Certification – Director Sueng (宋红茹), Certification Center, China Electronics Standardization Institute, MII
3. Debate (proposed topics) (for/against)

- A. The earlier the products enter the Catalog, the better/(worse) for business development;
- B. The raw materials should be the earliest ones to be placed on the Catalog/(Raw materials should NOT be the only earliest ones to be placed on the Catalog);
- C. Exemptions should/(should not) be introduced in the Catalog;
- D. The basis for placement in the Catalog should be technically mature, economically viable and most business can implement/(The Catalog should be able to guide the industrial development, products with great export, wide applications and high market share should be introduced);
- E. At present 3C certification is well established, 3C certification for RoHS should also adopt this mode/(Even though 3C certification is well established; however, the 3C Certification for RoHS should have some breakthrough).

(We are still looking for the debaters, additions and proposals of other topics of interest are also welcome.)
